

## Asian InsTech Working Group in Shenzhen, China

On March 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>, 2019 representatives and executives from GHQ Japan, Rep Offices China, DLVN (Vietnam), SUD (India), OLI (Thailand), DLINA (USA) and from DLIAP (Singapore) came together for the first Asian InsTech Working Group in Shenzhen, China.

Participants had the opportunity to learn from Chinese leading Technology & Insurance companies and their ecosystem over the two days. The event supported our objective to develop a mindset of pursuing and adapting Instech as a group.

The Final of the Dai-ichi Life Innovation Challenge (in cooperation with *agorize*), which the Group launched at the end of 2018, took place on the second day of the event. From initially over 120 InsTech Start-ups,



5 companies were selected to join us *Dai-ichi Life Innovation Challenge: Top 5 Startups & their propositions mapped on the Value Chain* in Shenzhen to pitch their propositions to the Group.

The Jury finally decided on our three winners:

### First Prize:



*India based Lyfas developed a digital health screening and underwriting mobile app that offers a non-invasive way to screen for health conditions through a set of simple tests & provides holistic disease management.*

### Second Prize:



*Singapore based Glee Trees' Gleematic software is a cognitive automation solution with Artificial Intelligence. It can automate various internal and back-office processes using RPA technology.*

### Third Prize:



*Know Your Customer, based in Hong Kong & Singapore is a technology partner, solving the challenges of digitizing KYC processes and user-friendly electronic signatures by combining both in a seamless app that lets customers electronically submit proof of identity and sign policies.*
